tumah טמאה Impurity

tumah describes a state of ritual impurity.

A person or object which contracts *tumah* is said to be tamei

and thereby unsuited for certain holy activities *kedusha* until undergoing predefined purification actions that usually include the elapse of a specified time-period.

to be used for *kedusha*.

The most common method of achieving *taharah* is by a person or object being immersed in a *mikveh*.

"Impure" is too negative.

It simply means not allowed while in service to God's manifestation

e.g. Entering the Temple, eating sacrificial foods.

There is no rule in Judaism never to become "tamei".

In fact, one can become impure by performing the mitzvah of tending to a dead person, or giving birth, or having a period. No wrongdoing is implied.

It is not intended as punishment.

Statute

A statute, ordinance or decree that surpasses understanding. As there is no apparent logic; therefore, it is of absolute Divine origin.

Two types of commandments:

chukkim and mishpatim statutes and ordinances

A "statute" (chok) is a commandment whose rationale escapes us.

An "ordinance" is one whose rationale is understandable (no murder, no stealing, etc.)

24 For I will take you from among the nations and gather you out of all the countries, and I will bring you back into your own land.

25 I will also sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. I will cleanse you from all your impurities and all your idols.

26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you; I will remove your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.

Statute

The Ordinance of the Red Heifer parah adumah 7278 72 Red Heifer



1. Find a red heifer that is completely unblemished and never used as a beast of burden.

...unless you read

Talmud states a Red Heifer is only valid if:

It is at least three years old (younger is a "calf", not a "cow").

It is natural-born (not by Caesarian).

It has not mated with a bull sent to mate with it (but if the bull does it on its own, it is valid).

It has no more than one hair that is not red.

Disqualified if a bird lands on it.

The most mysterious statute the chok is the Red Heifer.

that it is the most inexplicable commandment.

18 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers,

19 but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, the blood of Christ.

The Messiah was a Lamb without blemish and without spot (ἀμώμου, amomos.)

13 For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that their bodies are clean,

14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

The sacrifice of the Heifer is symbolic of Jesus Christ's divine sacrifice;

Red Heifer & Scarlet Wool point to Jesus' blood

A Heifer is a female and potential life-giver which points to the life-giving force of Jesus' atonement.

Water of cleansing pertains to the symbolic purification of the defiled person.

Water physically cleanses a person with dirty hands, Water of cleansing ritually purifies a defiled soul.

- 9 'Then a man who is clean shall gather up the ashes of the heifer, and store them outside the camp in a clean place; and they shall be kept for the congregation of the children of Israel for the water of purification; it is for purifying from sin.
- 10 'The one who gathers the ashes of the heifer shall wash his clothes and be unclean until evening; and it shall be a perpetual statute to the sons of Israel and to the alien who sojourns among them.

The ashes could last a very long time, since large amounts of water could be added to them (no density is specified in Torah).

In 70 AD, Rome sacked Jerusalem. Some ashes may have been left, but there are none left now.

Temple instruments and furnishings have been created.

The building <u>blueprints</u> are being drafted.

The kohanim (priests) have been genetically identified and are being trained in the <u>Temple's school</u>.

The High Priest (Kohen Gadol) has been appointed by the nascent <u>Sanhedrin council</u> in anticipation of <u>Yom Kippur</u> (Day of Atonement), the one day of the year when the High Priest enters the Holy of Holies in the Temple to make atonement for the nation of Israel.


